**The Payment Policy**

We ask that students pay for lessons by the month in order to hold their lesson time. Payment is due in full at the first lesson each month. The center accepts cash or checks. Sorry, credit cards are not accepted.

In the event that you need to cancel a lesson, we ask that the center is notified by 9:00 AM on the morning of the lesson. Make-up lessons are offered for cancelled lessons. Make-up lessons must be used within three months of the missed lesson. The lesson fee will not be refunded and a make-up lesson will not be offered if the lesson is not cancelled and the rider does not attend their lesson.

If a student needs to be away for an extended period of time, their lesson time may be held by paying for the lesson time to hold that time. Lesson times cannot be held without advance payment.

# Welcome to the Marlborough Equestrian Center!

We are a full service facility specializing in hunt seat riding.



## The Facility

Marlborough Equestrian Center is situated on 30+ acres on the Marlborough/Southborough line.

The Equestrian Center has more than 35 box stalls in three barns with a tack room in each barn. The main barn is attached to an indoor riding arena equipped with a sprinkler system and a heated viewing room.

There are three outdoor riding rings including the main ring which is a 100' x 200' sand ring with lights and a sprinkler system. The other two rings accommodate horse shows held on the farm.

Turn out is provided in several individual turn out areas and a large field for group turn out.

Full care services are offered to our boarders. Some of the services offered include clipping, trimming, mane pulling, sheath cleaning, laundry, worming and wound/injury care.



## The Lesson Program

An extensive lesson program is offered to all levels of riders from the beginner who has never ridden to the advanced rider who may be interested in horse showing.

Lessons are offered Tuesday through Sunday with both group and private lessons available. The center is closed on Mondays. Group lessons are made up of riders at the same level with no more than four riders.

Advanced students have the opportunity of leasing a horse to enjoy more riding time outside their lessons. Practice rides are also offered.

## Frequently Asked Questions

**Q.** Are trail rides offered?

**A.** No, trail rides are not offered.

**Q.** What equipment do I need to participate in riding lessons?

**A.** Riders need to wear long pants and boots with a low flat heel. Riding in sneakers or shorts is not permitted. Helmets are provided. We recommend purchasing your own helmet if you intend to ride for some length of time.

**Q.** How early should I arrive before my lesson time?

**A.** Because all students are responsible for tacking their lesson horse, riders should arrive approximately 30 minutes before your lesson time to allow time for grooming and tacking. If tacking assistance is needed, this will be included in the lesson time.

**Q.** How old do children need to be to take lessons?

**A.** Children as young as four years old may take private lessons. Children need to be six years old to ride in a group lesson.
