Due to recent occurrences of Equine Infectious Anemia at several horse shows, MEC requires an original Coggins test dated within 6 months of the show date. Thank you for your cooperation, we wish to keep all of our equine friends healthy!!

DIRECTIONS: From the North and South: From 495, use exit 24A for Route 20E in Marlborough. At the second set of lights, take a right onto South Street. Follow this to the set of lights at the end. Turn right onto Route 85S / Maple Street. At the next set of lights, turn right onto Mill Street South. Take an almost immediate left onto the continuation of Mill Street South. M.E.C.'s driveway will be on your right, after BROX Asphalt Plant. Follow the paved driveway into the farm. From the Mass. Pike: Use the Route 495 exit and follow the directions above. From Route 290: Follow 290 East to Route 495.

- 55. MODIFIED MINI-MEDAL Fences 2'-2'3"
- 62. MEC MINI-MEDAL Fences 2'3" to 2'6".
- 69. MEC MEDAL CLASS Fences 2'9" to 3'.

Class & Division Descriptions EQUITATION DIVISIONS

Leadline Equitation Division: Open to riders 7 and under who have not competed in any show off the leadline. Leader must be 16 or older. Riders may not cross enter. Emphasis is on the rider's position.

- 18. Leadline Equitation on the flat
- 19. Leadline Equitation over ground poles
- 20. Leadline Championship

Beginner Walk-Trot Equitation Division: Open to riders who have not competed over fences at any horse show. Riders may cross enter into Beginner Walk-Trot Hunter Division Only. Emphasis is on rider's position and control of mount. NO GREEN HORSES PLEASE.

Beginner Canter Equitation Division: Open to riders of any age who have not competed over fences at the canter at any horse show. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter. Riders may cross enter into the Walk-Trot Divisions (not Beginner Walk-Trot). NO GREEN HORSES.

Walk-Trot Equitation Division: Open to riders of any age who have not competed over fences higher than 18" in divisions that require the canter. To be shown on the flat at the walk and trot only. Fences 18". Riders may cross enter into Walk-Trot Hunter Division and the Beginner Canter Division. NO GREEN HORSES PLEASE.

Long Stirrup Equitation Division: Open to riders 13 and over who have not competed over fences higher than 18" at any horse show. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter. Fences 18".

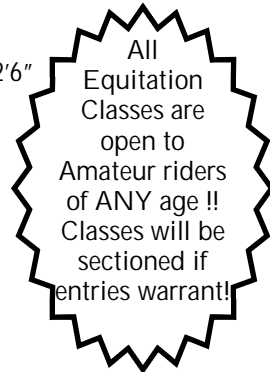

HUNTER DIVISIONS

Green Hunter Division: Open to green horses and ponies in their first or second year of showing who have not competed over fences higher than 18" at any horse show. To be shown on the flat at the walk and trot only. Cross entry into the Elementary Hunter Division and the Pleasure Division. Fences 18" verticals.

37. Green Hunter Under Saddle
38. Green Hunter A
39. Green Hunter B

Elementary Hunter Division: Open to green horses and ponies who have not competed over fences higher than 18" in any competition. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter. Cross entry into the Green Hunter Division only. Fences 18" verticals. No more than 8 to canter at one time.

Beginner Walk-Trot Hunter Division: Open to horses/ponies ridden by riders who have not competed over fences at any horse show. Riders may cross enter into Beginner Walk-Trot Equitation Only. Emphasis is on the manners of the mount as a beginner mount, soundness and way of going. NO GREEN HORSES.

Walk-Trot Hunter Division: Open to horses of any status to be ridden by riders of any age who have not competed over fences higher than 18" in divisions that require the canter. To be shown on the flat at the walk and trot only. Riders may cross enter into Walk-Trot Equitation Division and the Beginner Canter Division. Fences 18". NO GREEN HORSES PLEASE.

Pleasure Division: Open to horses/ponies and riders of any status. Judged on manners, performance, presence and soundness. Mounts should stand quietly and back readily.
